

## Freshmen Connection Schedule Planning Guidelines

To plan your fall schedule:

1. View the [Course Recommendations](http://ter.ps/fccourses) [link: <http://ter.ps/fccourses>] for your intended major. Planning on more than one major? Look at the recommendations for both or contact an FC advisor for additional assistance.
2. Print out the list of Courses by [General Education](http://ter.ps/fcgened) [link: <http://ter.ps/fcgened>] to see at a glance which fall courses fulfill General Education requirements recommended for your major.
3. View the live [Schedule of Classes](http://ter.ps/fcsoc) [link: <http://ter.ps/fcsoc>] for course descriptions, times, and availability. Section numbers for all FC courses begin with *FC*.
4. Make sure that the courses you're choosing aren't offered at conflicting times by utilizing a [Scheduling Worksheet](http://ter.ps/fcworksheet) [link: <http://ter.ps/fcworksheet>].
5. Keep in mind the following:
  - a. Some courses offer multiple sections or have discussions that meet at different times and/or locations. Make sure to note which section (i.e. FC01, FC02, FC03) works for your schedule as you'll need to include this on the FC Enrollment Form.
  - b. Full-time status for University of Maryland undergraduate students is based on registration for 12 or more credits per semester (at least four three-credit courses). You are encouraged to take a full academic load.
  - c. Tuition for Freshmen Connection is charged at a flat rate for up to 17 credits, including UNIV 100.
  - d. If you are enrolling in Marching Band, Repertoire Ensemble or Air Force or Naval ROTC, be sure to submit the additional form(s) required to enroll in these courses.
